

POOL RULES

A heated swimming pool is available for resident's use from Memorial Day through Labor Day weekend.

The pool belongs to everyone; enforcement of the rules and regard for safety is every resident's responsibility. Each Co-owner, resident and guest uses the pool at his/her own risk.

- Pool hours are: 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Weekdays,
11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Weekends and Holidays
In August the pools close at 8:00 p.m. because of early sunset
No swimming after hours.
- No diving, running, or rough play.
- Safety equipment must not be tampered with or used for anything other than its intended purpose.
- No pets within the fenced in area.
- **No smoking in the pool area.**
- No food allowed at the pool. Beverages must be in unbreakable containers only.
NO GLASS for the safety of everyone!
- Residents must accompany and be responsible for guests. Please inform all guests of pool rules. Lack of compliance may cause banishment from pool use.
- Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by an adult. Non-toilet trained or diapered babies are not allowed in the pool in compliance with Michigan Department of Health Act 368 of the Public Act. of 1978 rules for swimming pools.
- Clean swimwear only. It is advisable to shower before swimming to remove excess tanning lotions.
- Should the pool be closed during normal pool hours for reasons other than inclement weather, a notice will be displayed at the pool gate or on the website: Highlandergroup.net
